<b>Error Type</b>	<b>Error diary example</b>
<b><i>Capture</i></b> (Automatic activation of a well-learned routine that overrides the current intended activity)	
<b><i>Double Capture</i></b> (The unintended activation of a related strong action schema)	
<b><i>Omission</i></b> (Due to interruptions)	
<b><i>Loss of Activation</i></b> (Schemas that have been activated lose activation)	
<b><i>Description Slip</i></b> (Incomplete or ambiguous specification of intention that is similar to a familiar intention)	
<b><i>Associative Activation Slip</i></b> (Activation of similar but incorrect schemas)	
<b><i>Repetition of Action Slip</i></b> (Repetition of an correctly performed action)	
<b><i>Cross-talk Slip (concurrent)</i></b> (Action components are exchanged between two or more concurrent actions)	
<b><i>Cross-talk Slip (sequential)</i></b> (Action components are exchanged between two or more sequential actions)
